Director of Operation's Report

Moved Up Fall Scheduling

- Classic Fall Schedule posted to East Central website
- Feedback on earlier timeline. First year with pre-Labor Day games
 - ➤ Games have not started so feedback on the early start time will be discussed more at future meeting.
 - o First day of school for many schools is September 1
 - Happens that this year the Wednesday that we have games scheduled will be the first day of school for many players
 - ➤ High School girls have a lot of school activities on Saturday, and they should have their games scheduled for Sunday. Clubs are in the process of rescheduling games to Sunday for their High School Girls

New player Photo Rosters

- All rosters must be printed in color
- Player photos need to be a clear head/shoulder shot, unacceptable photos will result in the roster being placed in pending until a suitable photo is entered
- Coaches/Managers (see Risk Management points)

Club Passing

- Team using club pass players will be required to supply a copy of both their Official Roster AND the Official Roster of the team the club pass player is assigned to.
- If using Rec Players, must have head/shoulder photo

Player Pass Cards

- Card requests must ONLY come from teams that need them for their league/tournament.
- WYSA has announce that the follow events must have player cards.
 - ➤ Youth National League
 - > State Cup
 - > Presidents Cup
- Please do not wait until the last minute to request cards. Allow one full week for processing
- If you are planning to club pass any recreational players, have them submit a picture to their personal record in Demosphere so that it appears on the recreational roster.

Risk Management Completion - Coaches and Manager

- Clubs are responsible for ensuring coaches and managers complete all phases of risk management
- Team Rosters MUST have at least one coach who has completed all phases of risk management for the roster to be approved by the District Registrar.
- Coaches/Managers who have not completed all parts of the Risk Management process must be removed from the roster before it is approved. Once all parts of the risk management have been completed the roster can be submitted for approval.

Referee – Justin Oshefsky

- New referee courses are still being held now. 1st time referees will have fee's reimbursed by WYSA. Also including is a 1st year referee kit. If interested, please take advantage of this offer in August. No word from WYSA if this offer will be valid in Winter Classes.
- Please work with referees this fall on no player passes just rosters. WISREF has not sent anything out on this matter yet.

- We were able to host Mentoring sessions at five tournaments this past spring. Mike and I are working on hosting more mentoring at academy games this fall. It will largely depend on referee availability as we were short refs in the spring.
- We Applied for Mentoring reimbursement but seems WYSA changes the criteria each time we submit it.
- Had about dozen or so games this past spring without a referee or missing 1 ref.
 Mainly U8/U10 games. Specially on locations without a referee pool. Games were uncovered mainly due to no one wanting to pick game up.
- Referee pool this fall will be limited. I will be difficult to have full crews on all games but will work our hardest. All games on Weekends + Academy + Tournaments. Not to mention HS games/college games/etc.
 - o How can we help?
 - Back-to-back games when we can.
 - Not every game can start at 1pm.
 - Willingness to move games
 - Notify assignor ASAP when games are or will be moved/cancelled

Discussion:

- Chris suggested that we may want to look at ways to give clubs more freedom to move games within a few hours so that clubs can fill up whose to get referees at their game.
- Question from a parent's perspective in that the referees are seeing games that are not filled but are unable to select them. Feeling that it is not a good summer job as they are not able to get enough games to make it worth their while. Asked for suggestions on how to find more games for the referee that is looking for more.

Adult League – Vicki King

- 160 players were registered and played in the Spring 2021 Adult League. Games are completed for the Spring 2021 Adult League. WSL mailed registration fees to the individual clubs.
- Look at registration for next season. Currently the WSL registrar has the only access to the registrations.

Discussion:

- Concern over the gender rule that once at the game the opposing team is requesting the other team waive the rule because they are short on girls.
 - Chris asked that we table this discussion to a time when more members can weigh in on the adult program.

Academy - Sean Breitzman

- Numbers are healthy for the fall season. As usual they fluctuate from club to club, but overall, they look good.
- No mega date this year due to lack of referees and a hosting site.

• Change to 8U format: instead of being separated by skill level, 8U teams will be made evenly split to help with scheduling and encourage player development through more inclusivity sand encouraging fluid pool rosters.

Old Business

Addressing the High School age players needs in East Central

- With player numbers dropping, realistically East Central will continue to struggle with providing U division for each age beyond 13U
- East year we have issues when clubs form a team specifically to play in a specific age group yet there are not sufficient other teams in the U division and divisions are combined
- Clubs are often not extending offers to players who are too old, but who ultimately could play once that team is moved into combined division
- In order to provide consistent league programming, we will be looking at the following changes in the Classic League
 - Provide only a 15U classic division (which includes 15U and 14U) in the seasons when we have displaced 8th graders
 - > Fall for Boys/Coed Divisions
 - > Spring for Girls Divisions
- Have a High School Summer Girls Classic Division which will encompass all age groups 15U-19U, if there are enough teams to make two divisions, we would have a Classic 1 and Classic 2
- Review current Classic Fall 2021 Girls divisions and assess whether the same set up for Summer would also be best for Fall
- Look at historical data and review if there are benefits to establishing predetermined age divisions for Boys High School Age players.

New Business

2022-2023 Budget Committee

- Need to take a fresh look at not only how our funds are spent, but what and who benefits from the services we provide
- Currently over 90% of our revenue is from individual Players fees
 - o These fees are not very equitable
 - o Player counts are difficult to get, ever changing and not always accurate
- With Player Cards going away, there is now only a select few players who receive this service
- The last attempt at moving to Team Fees was a bit rushed and Covid virtual meeting were not a good forum for discussion
 - Hope to form a Budget Committee and have some preliminary work to present at the October All Club Meeting
 - From there, a Final Budget will be drafted and presented at the January 2022
 AGM
 - o Plenty of time for clubs to adapt their budgets/fees for the 2022/2023 Season

Fall East Central DOC/Coaching Meeting

- Hoping for a date and an 'in person meeting' either the end of September or early October
- Will be sending out an email to clubs for feedback and to accumulate contact information for DOC.
